

# Polished Porcelain Tile

---

On some polished surfaces, the presence of an 'oily' film can be observed due to the 'stain-resistant' treatment applied to the surface of the tiles during the manufacturing process. Once all the material has been laid and the remains of the cement and any setting material have been removed, if this film is still visible, we recommend cleaning the surface of polished porcelain tiles with dry cleaning products (detergents in powder form) and, once this fine protective film has been eliminated, clean the tiles as indicated above. In extreme lighting conditions, light reflections may occur due to the high degree of brightness and the characteristics of the product. We recommend cleaning all stains immediately.

# Ceramic Wall Tile

---

For ceramic wall tile cleaning, use any non-abrasive cleaning compound recommended for tile.

# Natural Stone

---

Tile sealers serve to protect and beautify your investment. Sealing may be necessary for certain types of tile, such as some quarry tile, Saltillo tile and natural stone. Ask your tile supplier or manufacturer if your specific tile requires sealing, stripping
